TOPICS

1. My Oral Tradition

- * Who are two of the most important people in your life?
- * Why is each person important to you?
- * Relate a story from your childhood that you remember.
- * Relate a story from your life that you do not remember.

2. My Roots:

- * What is most important to you about your:
 - a. family background
 - b. religious background
 - c. cultural background

3. My Journey up to now:

- * What events have had an influence on your life - accomplishments, prizes, moves, awards, changes, etc?

4. My inspiration:

- * Using a person, prayer, poem, or a story, show what it means to you and explain how it gives you hope or helps you to become the best person you can be..

5. My name:

- * Give some background about your name. For example:
 - What does it mean?
 - Where it came from.
 - Why you like it or don't like it?
 - How you got it?
 - What it would look like if you illustrated it?

6. My favourite Bible Story

- * Explain what your favourite bible story is. When did you first hear it? Write out the passage (or part of it), giving the correct citation.

7. My Psalm

Psalms are songs and poems about life (praise, penitential - forgiveness and pardon, Thanksgiving, adoration and blessing). Psalms are either individual or communal.

- * Choose a psalm from the Bible that relates to your life. If you do not know of a Psalm choose your favourite song and explain why it speaks to your life.
